SCHOOL REOPENING PLAN REMINDERS

High School

- Students should not be dropped off prior to 7:30 a.m. They will not be invited to enter the building until 7:30 a.m. unless supervised by a coach, teacher, activity sponsor or school district employee.
- All high school students will enter through the High School main door under the blue bricks on the west side of the building off 18th Street.
- Parents/Guardians who are also dropping off students at the Middle School will need to drop off Middle School students separately at the Middle School circle drive entrance.2
- High school students will have an early out at 1:45 p.m.
- At the end of the school day, all students must exit the building within 15 minutes after the last bell unless supervised by a coach, teacher, activity sponsor, or school district employee.
- Students will not be able to wait in the school for evening activities to begin. Parents should make arrangements to follow this dismissal/exit time.
