Superintendent Clark Wicks shared the Disaster Proclamation to Assist Perry Recovery signed by Governor Kim Reynolds.

Mr. Wicks also updated and shared information with the Board on the Return To School Plan.

COMMENDATIONS

The Perry Elementary Title 1 Team has done an outstanding job meeting students where they are at, to ensure that students have access to interventions that meet their specific needs. This year we have had 28 GEI meetings to review students who are struggling to meet standards in the classroom. In nearly every meeting, the Title 1 team has attended and shared the student's individual Title Profile that outlines what skills the student has, areas where they are lacking, and details about the specific interventions and instruction they have received. The Title 1 teachers' willingness to adjust instruction, shuffle groups, and adapt to meet the needs of all learners ensures that all students have access to high quality interventions. In addition, the Title 1 teachers have been instrumental in supporting classroom teachers with the implementation of UFLI

phonics curriculum, and also have subbed in classrooms countless times already this year. Their initiative to support students and their colleagues is greatly appreciated, and the Title 1 teachers are an asset to Perry Elementary! Ben Phillips is doing a great job with the French speaking newcomers. He is fluent in French and has assisted a lot in communicating with these students. Having a bilingual ELL teacher has been a great resource.

Chris Aggen, Elementary Dean of Students, and Adam Jessen, Middle School Assistant Principal and Assistant Director of Learning Supports, have been a tremendous addition to our administrative team. Mr. Aggen and Mr. Jessen both jump in to help anyone at any time and are willing to take on new tasks whenever asked. At the elementary, Mr. Aggen has been essential in responding to support calls, handling student discipline, and helping with truancy. He takes on every task with high efficiency and is willing to do whatever he can to help teachers and fellow administrators. Despite being a University of Michigan fan, he's a great addition to Perry Elementary! (You can delete that line, but it is true). As Assistant Director of Learning Supports, Mr. Jessen has jumped in to the world of Special Education with grace and willingness to learn and support in any way that he can. He's an eager learner who asks questions and wants to learn more to build his tool box.
